
DISTANCE TO ABORTION: WISCONSIN

Even before the fall of Roe v. Wade, people seeking abortions in central and northern Wisconsin had to travel over 75 miles to a clinic. According to ANSIRH, there were only four clinics in the state.

When Wisconsin's 1849 abortion ban went into effect in June 2022, people living in the outlined area lost close access to abortion care. The **2.1 million** inhabitants here make up 36% of Wisconsin's total populaiton, according to the ACS.

Restrictions next door

While abortion is legal in Michigan and Iowa, both states have restrictions that make it hard to access. Guttmacher Institutes outlines some of these additional barriers to care:

- · 2 clinic appointments required
- 24 hour waiting period
- Medicaid does not cover abortion care
- Only physicians can provide abortions
- Parental consent for minors

Access within reach

According to Planned Parenthood, both Illinois and Minnesota have few restrictions on abortion. These are both states where Wisconsin patients now travel to access the abortion care they need.
